### Commitment to achieving Net Zero

Intelligent Delivery Solutions Ltd (IDS) is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050.

### Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline Year: 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 – 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023 – Same as current year

Our baseline emissions includes all our measurable scope 1 and scope 2 emissions, together with the following Scope 3 categories:

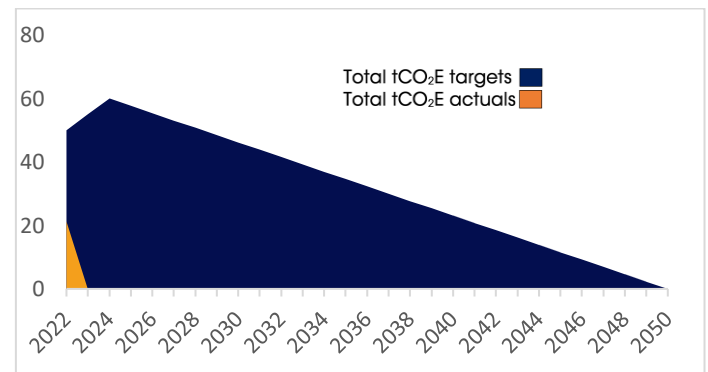

## Emissions Reduction targets

In order to continue our progress toward achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will increase over the next two years to 60tCO<sub>2</sub>e by 2025. This will be an increase of 20%. This will be caused by the growth of IDS, and the number of people working from home having a further impact on the Scope 3 emissions.

## Carbon Reduction Projects

### Completed Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been implemented since the 2022 baseline program began. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these will be reviewed in next year's carbon reduction plan.

- Launched an Environment Policy
- Initiated an internal Net Zero project, including attending Journey To Net Zero training run by The Growth Company.
- Engaged the team in minimising travel and using forms of transport that have a lesser impact on the environment
- Engaged with Staze, a sustainable hotel booking platform
- In a post-pandemic world IDS are working from home for the majority of the time

### Future Initiatives

In the future, we will implement measures that will continue to drive down emissions. Initiatives being considered are:

- Continuously work to collect high-quality data to aid in the reduction and accurate measurement of the IDS carbon footprint.
- Work with landlords to measure electric, gas, and water consumption.
- Monitor and reduce business travel footprint with a policy to promote sustainable travel choices.
- Engage with a Trees for Life partner
- Align IDS with ISO14001 with a view to becoming ISO14001 certified.
- Examine how to reduce emissions from employees working from home as IDS grows.
